Your letter dated September 17, 2007 was received in our office, with attachments, on that date.

I repeat a portion of Mr. Allan T. Snell, Q.C.'s letter to you dated March 16, 2005:

"Not every connection or inter-relationship represents a conflict of interest; a lawyer is in a conflict of interest where he or she might be seen to be tempted to prefer the interests of one client over another. You have not given us any indication that the interests of the RM of Edenwold and those of Ms. Strudwick diverge in any meaningful way. Lawyers often represent a corporate entity and a principal or senior employee of that corporate entity. Furthermore, clients may, in some circumstances, waive potential conflicts of interest in order to be represented by counsel of their choice."

The further matters which you raise in your letter of September 17, 2007 have been the subject of review by the courts from the Court of Queen's Bench to the Supreme Court of Canada. The Law Society of Saskatchewan has no jurisdiction to make a determination on these matters.
